ENTRETECHNOLOGY ANNOUNCES EXTENSION TO MULTIMILLION DOLLAR OEM PC CONTRACT

FORT WORTH, Texas -- March 1, 2006 -- EntreTechnology announced today that the contract for OEM PC fulfillment would be extended for the next generation of PCs. EntreTechnology was originally awarded up to half of the PC shipments in the later part of 2004 and all of 2005. The computer provided by EntreTechnology will be integrated with the customer's flagship Immunochemistry analyzer and shipped worldwide. The customer is a global, multibillion-dollar, broad-based health care company.

"In 2005 we shipped 700 units with 100% on-time and 100% quality performance. When the customer evaluated our proposal on the next generation of products we once again scored relatively even with the multi-billion dollar incumbent," said Gary Clayton, Vice President for EntreTechnology. "Our total business with this customer has increased four-fold in the past three years. We're very excited about continuing to expand our products and customer base throughout the Clinical Lab and Medical Equipment Manufacturing segments."

The contract calls for EntreTechnology to configure up to 100 Windows-based PCs per month and ship it to the customer for further delivery worldwide. EntreTechnology expects the contract to be valued at over \$1 million per year, but did not disclose exact unit volume and dollar value.
